| These price estimates are from Meininger Art Supply downtown Colo. Springs 1 sheet (22x30) 140 lb. Arches, cold press <u>watercolor paper</u> | \$6 |

| 1 large, round <u>watercolor</u> brush with good point, about size #20 to 32, Meininger brand or Princeton Neptune <u>Quill</u> #8 or #6 (can find on Amazon or online) AND 1 small to medium, round watercolor brush with good point, size #6 to #10, | \$17 |
| Meininger brand or Princeton Neptune is fine OR 4 Piece Princeton Professional Brush Set #300 on Amazon | \$7 \$29 |
| Watercolor Paint (please buy professional grade in Daniel Smith, Winsor Newton, or Holbein in the 5ml or larger 15ml tubes) Please bring the paint you already have. These are some of the colors that I use a lot and if you don't have them, you might want to supplement your current palette with a few: | |
| Cobalt blue, Ultramarine Blue, Cerulean, Burnt Sienna, Hansa Yellow Light, Aureolin Yellow Cobalt, Quinacridone Rose, and Sap Green \$20 to \$36 | |
| 1 white/clear, <u>corrugated plastic</u> (18x24) at Meiningers, to tape paper to OR <u>Gatorfoam board</u> to staple paper to (see my stretching paper video on Youtube) | \$3 |
| 1 watercolor palette <u>with lid</u> and mixing areas or white plastic plate (A good starter option - Creative Mark Folding Plastic Palette \$4 www.jerrysartaram | \$5 na.com) |
| 1 roll of paper towels (viva or bounty are best) | \$3 |
| 1 roll, high adhesion, 1" masking tape by Scotch (found at Home Depot) | \$3 |
| Removable masking fluid by Pebeo – called Pebeo Drawing Gum | \$7 |
| 1 Spray bottle with variable spray, not mist | \$3 |
| Sketch book (6x8 or larger, <u>can be already used</u>) | \$4 |
