Course Description

Experience an introduction to the world of hot glass through the guided creation of unique solid sculptural items. Begin with an inspirational tour of the magnificent Dale Chihuly collection at the Fine Arts Center. Following the tour and a short demonstration, you'll start to create your own works of glass.

This is an outdoor class so be sure to dress appropriately for the weather.

- 30 minute tour of Fine Arts Center Chihuly Collection
- 30 minute demonstration and introduction to Glassblowing
- 2 hours creation period where students will make their pieces

- Create a piece of glasswork with guidance.
- Understand the purpose of a kiln in the annealing process.
