Supplies:

Oil or Acrylic Paint colors: Titanium White, Cad Yellow Light or Pale, Cad Yellow Medium, Cad Red Light, Alizarin Crimson or Quinacridone Rose, Phthalo Green or Viridian, Cerulean Blue, Ultramarine Blue. \$6-\$10 per 37 ml tube. If using acrylics, I recommend a heavy body acrylic paint. ----- \$48.00-\$80.00

Palette (Disposable is okay) ----- \$14.00

Bristle Brushes, variety of sizes 2-6 \$5-\$6 per brush ----- \$10.00-\$36.00

Paper Towels ----- \$3.00

Odorless Mineral Spirits if using oils and sealed container ----- \$10.00-\$20.00

Palette Knife ----- \$4.00

Painting Support, at least 2, Pre-stretched canvas, canvas panel, or canvas paper taped onto a board, 12x16 or similar size ----- \$12.00-\$20.00

Sketchbook (any size) ----- \$6.00

Soft lead pencil ----- \$2.00

Optional: Prussion Blue Oil or Acrylic Paint (37 ml tube) ----- \$6.00-\$10.00

Optional: Paint Medium: Galkyd Gel for oils or Acrylic Paint Impasto ----- \$12.00
