For this class, you will need to purchase a few supplies on your own and the rest will be provided by the instructor with a \$35 materials fee. The materials fee should be given to the instructor on the first day of class. Students may opt to bring their own materials, but please check with the instructor first to make sure they are appropriate for the projects intended.

If buying their own supplies, the instructor suggests students purchase their bead supplies from Beads & Needs bead shop, located at 5154 Centennial Blvd, Colorado Springs, CO 80906, (719)599-3300, because they have a broad variety of seed bead colors and sizes. White Rabbit Beads on 2421 Colorado Ave, Colorado Springs, CO 80904, (719)635-0035, also has a good selection of individual beads, and may have some Czech hank beads

*If students want to select and buy their beads for the netted necklace only, they can subtract that cost of \$15.50 from the materials fee paid to the instructor. If they have beading needles and a fuzzy cloth, or any other supply, they can also subtract that from the fee if they do not wish to purchase more, but please let the instructor know before class if possible.
