## **Supplies**

Several tubes or bottles of your favorite colors in acrylic paint. Be sure to include black and white plus a "metallic" like gold, silver, or bronze. \$60.00	
Three canvases (or more!) at least size $16 \times 20$ , one canvas should be at least $12 \times 12 \times 12 \times 12 \times 18 \times 18 \times 18 \times 18 \times $	36 (larger canvases in \$50.00+
Roll or package of palette paper or wax paper (needs to be disposable)	\$10.00
Masking Tape	\$3.50
Disposable Gloves	\$4.50
Several palette knives in metal or plastic	\$7.50
5 inexpensive, throw-away brushes ("chip" brushes") such as at Harbor Freight	\$10.00
3 inexpensive foam rollers (such as you paint the walls with) in various sizes	\$5.00
One box inexpensive facial tissues without lotion	\$1.00
Acrylic ink in several colors (sets available) to include black	\$30.00 for a six-pack
Acrylic mat or gloss "Fluid" Medium	\$10.00
Pearl Ex Powders (or similar brand)	\$5.00
Spray bottles (2) for water and alcohol (please fill with alcohol at home)	\$5.00
1 can of spray air	\$3.50
Disposable paper cups to mix acrylic paint & medium in	\$3.00
