Items from home would include bringing your own apron or smock, and a hand towel so you have your own clean set.

### **Supplies**

Paper – One package of 8x10 multi-grade RC paper (25-sheets). Choose any surface – glossy, matte, or pearl. Do not open the paper! The paper will be ruined if exposed to white light. We will discuss proper handling of light sensitive paper. Over 8 weeks you might use more, so consider a 50-sheet box for \$55.00. \$30.00 for a 25-sheet pack
