The instructor does not expect everyone to buy all brand new materials, but if you're unsure about your existing supplies, consult her ahead of time with questions and ideas. Below is a suggested list of supplies, you're welcome to email the instructor for links to her specific brand suggestions. The prices are based on Blick supplies.

Remember you will be outside! Prepare for the weather and keep in mind you will be carrying everything you need, the instructor personally uses a messenger bag.

Supplies

Set of 5 synthetic watercolor paint brushes	\$10
Set of 6-12 watercolor TUBE paints with basic colors (high-er quality pan paints work too)	\$20
Moleskine watercolor notebook, 5 ½" x 3 ½" (any watercolor sketchbook under 8"x10" will work!)	\$25
CORE plastic water bottle	\$5
Mechanical pencil of any kind, 0.7mm or smaller	\$3
Pack of mechanical pencil lead (colored lead can be cool if you want!)	\$3
Folding palette box	\$6
ArtBin Sketch-Pac divided pencil box (optional, and if you get this, you don't need the palette box)	\$20

Total estimated cost \$72 (if you buy everything new)
