**Supplies**

Soft chalk pastel set, see Amazon (You can spend as much as you are willing, some Rembrandt or Holbein sets are \$\$\$) \$15+

Small sketchbook to develop thumbnails \$0, if found at home

Sketchbook with medium texture, 18 x 24" or no smaller than 11 x 14"; Canson/Strathmore/Bienfang are good, try Walmart or Michaels \$15-20

Single sheet(s) of Canson/MaTiente charcoal drawing paper, 18 x 24"; try cream, pink, or light colors \$3/sheet

Drawing board with clips (Michael's 23 x 26", \$26) or a piece of masonite (Home Depot, get it cut to 24 x 28", \$15 or less); large clips to secure paper to board; may clip paper to cardboard back of sketchbook \$15+

Optional: tracing or tissue paper to lay over drawing for transport \$5+

Optional: French easel. This can be helpful, but not necessary. Bring only if you already have one. Working outdoors assumes a measure of innovation needed to place the drawing board propped securely. \$0

Optional: blanket, or camp stool, wet wipes, brown bag lunch. May go off campus to buy lunch. \$0-10
