I do not expect everyone to buy all brand new materials, but if you're unsure about your existing supplies, consult me ahead of time with questions and ideas. Below is a suggested list of supplies, you're welcome to email me for links to my specific brand suggestions.

Hot tip if you're buying missing items: go to second hand art stores like Who Gives a Scrap, or garage sales, your friends, or ask local collectives if they have donated supplies available for free. Get thrifty!

I based the prices in this list on buying 100% new supplies only at Michaels.

Supplies

Set of at least 5 synthetic watercolor paint brushes in various sizes and shapes (I like the Princeton SNAP brand)	\$13
Set of 6-12 watercolor TUBE paints with basic colors (pan paints work too but I prefer tubes for mixing)	\$20
COLD PRESSED 9x12 or larger watercolor pad (I like the brands Canson or Fluid)	\$15
Mechanical pencil of any kind, 0.7mm or smaller	\$3
Pack of mechanical pencil lead (colored lead can be cool if you want!)	\$3
Palette of any size, as long as it has room for mixing (a flat area)(also, it doesn't need a cover but that's nice)	\$6
Printed figure reference (optional)
