Students are welcome to bring their own supplies such as pencils, paintbrushes, watercolors, and sketchbooks/paper. The list below has links to the items you need. I provide the actual watercolor in palettes but I listed the one I use if you would like to your own, they are OPTIONAL. I find the website provided (Blick.com) has some of the best prices. You can also search on Amazon or go to a local art store such as Meiningers for similar items. The items do not have to be exact!

I would recommend an apron and a rag/towel for this class as well. If you cannot get your supplies in a timely manner I do have a few you may borrow until you receive yours. Hover over items to see where to purchase and examples.

Supplies

Masking Fluid (or equivalent masking fluid, frisket, or can use rubber cement)	\$8-\$12
Pentel Aquash Water Brush - Set of 2 (or can order just one but I REALLY recommend this brand) Hobby Lobby also sells individual ones of this brand. Koi brand is at Meiningers and will work too	\$7
Canson XL Watercolor Pad - 9" x 12" (at least 140lb paper)	\$10
OPTIONAL: Prang Watercolor Pans - Oval, Assorted, Set of 8 colors	\$4.00
