LEFT-HANDED STUDENTS Please note your calligraphy fountain pen or pen set should state on the package that it is for left-handed writers.

Supplies

Calligraphy (chisel-edge tip) marker pen: Elegant Writer, Master's Touch, Pitt, Pigma, or Manuscript
Calligraphy Marker, or similar, with Broad 3 mm tip

Pad of BLANK paper that takes ink well, 9"x12," 11"x14," or similar size (Master's Touch Writing Sheet Pad, Strathmore 400 Series calligraphy pad, or other) \$7-\$14

Dip pen holder (speedball or other), and Speedball C-2 dip pen nib (OPTIONAL: Speedball pen set with pen holder and C series pen nibs) \$5-\$16

Non-waterproof black ink (Higgins Fountain Pen India Ink or similar)

Calligraphy fountain pen/pen set (with CHISEL-EDGE NIBS): Fine Touch, Speedball, Manuscript, Staedtler, or other \$5-\$16

Optional: Gouache paint set (tubes or pans), pointed brush(es) \$9-\$20

Optional: Sheet of medium to heavy weight paper, smooth surface, that takes ink well (does not feather). Strathmore 500 series, Arches, Fabriano, or other \$5-\$12
