There are many brands of pastels and papers to choose from. Faber-Castell or Nupastel are widely carried. Purchase soft or hard pastels – not oil, oil sticks or pencils – as we will focus on chalk. I strongly suggest a pack of no less than 72 colors. For paper, I request you bring at least three sheets of a decent size – i.e. 18" x 24". Strathmore is a great brand and you can get it in an assorted colored paper pad of 24. However, you can get any drawing or watercolor paper. I request you get colored paper – not white – and no Bristol Board. Retailers include Meininger's (in town and they can order materials if they do not have on hand) Hobby Lobby, Michael's Amazon, DickBlick.com or Jerrysartarama.com.
