You will be able to find the items on this list locally or online. I recommend Cameraworks at Academy for an SLR camera, as they have a large selection of used, warrantied cameras. Also, Cameraworks provides a 20% discount to Bemis students for film and paper. Online, Freestyle Photographic Supply – www.freestylephoto.biz – has a large section of their own B&W brand film and paper called Arista EDU and it is priced very reasonably. Other brands to consider when buying film are Kodak Tri-X, Ilford HP5, Ilford FP4, Ilford Delta 100 or 400. For paper, I recommend Ilford Multi-grade RC Paper, or Arista EDU Multi-grade RC paper. Start with a 25-sheet pack. You can always purchase more. Other vendors include: Online - B&H Photo or Adorama and locally Mike's Camera and Denver Pro Photo.
