<u>Sakura Pigma Micron Pens</u> - Set of 3, Black Fine Sizes	\$7-\$10
Strathmore Watercolor Pad - 9" x 12" WIREBOUND (at least 140lb paper)	\$9
OR <u>Canson Montval Watercolor Pad 9"x12"</u> TAPEBOUND (at least 140lb paper)	\$9
OR <u>TOP OF LINE</u> Arches Watercolor paper 9 x 12 (at least 140lb paper)	\$19
OPTIONAL: Prang Watercolor Pans - Oval, Assorted, Set of 8 colors	\$4 (OPTIONAL)
