Bring an apron if you tend to or like to get messy! I will provide some other tools for demos. There are many brands of pastels and papers to choose from, please see my suggestions below.

Pastels: Faber-Castell or Nupastel are probably the most widely carried pastels. Purchase soft pastels – not oil, oil sticks, or pencils – as we will be focusing on chalk. I suggest at least a 72-color pack because there are more colors to work with. NOTE: If you wish to really invest in your pastel-making the following brands are best but come at a higher cost: Terry Ludwig, Sennelier, or Richeson.

Paper: I prefer you look for Strathmore Assorted Color Pastel Paper Pad of 24 sheets, 18"x24". Retailers include Meininger's (in town and they can order materials if they do not have on hand), Hobby Lobby, Michael's, Amazon, DickBlick.com, or Jerrysartarama.com.
