Meininger's in town has a great selection. The instructor will be using 8" x 10" paper. Bring your own paper towels and container for water. The watercolor paint prices are ranged from beginner (Cotman by Windsor & Newton is recommended) to professional (Windsor and Newton, Daniel Smith, etc.). Cotman is an excellent inexpensive choice.
