Supplies are available at Michaels, Hobby Lobby, Menninger's, Amazon, etc. Please bring an old apron (optional) and clothes you don't mind getting dirty, as well as a large towel. For basic safety as a guideline, please cut nails as short as possible before class begins (this means VERY short) and hair past the shoulder must be tied up to prevent injury while operating wheel from occurring.

You MUST purchase your brushes. I got mine from Meininger in Colorado Springs, so if you forget to purchase some, you can always go there in between classes. The brand of brushes I purchase are the Taklon brand, synthetic white brushes. The shorter the brush the better. Please get one 3/4" flat brush, one 1/2" flat brush, and one 1/4" flat brush and one 1/8" flat brush. The wider brushes are used for applying terra sig over a larger surface area quickly and the smaller ones or for detail work.

If you have used brushes that you don't use anymore, please bring them. These should work fine if they aren't gunked up.

For the materials fee, Venmo or cash is preferred. This is for the acquisition of materials and making of the terra sig and underglazes. Please pay the first day of class.
