If you are taking this class you are ready to invest in your pastel-making skills! If you have only hard pastels, it is time to supplement your sticks with the finer quality soft ones. I suggest brands such as Terry Ludwig, Richeson, Sennelier or Schminke in set numbers of 40 to 60 or more. Look for an assortment set. Paper: I prefer you look for Canson Mi Teintes Pastel paper assorted colors pack of 24, 19" x 25" – rather than a pack of white paper. Please do not buy Bristol Board. Retailers include Meininger's (in town and they can order materials if they do not have on hand,) Hobby Lobby or Michael's and on-line Amazon, Dakotapastels.com or DickBlick.com or Jerrysartarama.com. I will provide some other tools for demos.

Firm Soft White Eraser (Staedtler or Factis are good brands)	\$.79 - \$1.59
