Below I have the items you will need for this class. I have attached links for your convenience. I want to stress the importance of having the correct size/length of cotton cord. I encourage everyone to use the link provided to order that specific cotton cord. If you have trouble finding it available on amazon, please reach out to me so I can assist in finding a suitable replacement. If you have attended a class in the past and have a leftover cord, you are welcome to use that. Use your discretion throughout the course if you think you will need to order more or not. Not color specific.

Sharp scissors are necessary. If you have scissors that you are thinking of using but are not sure if they are sharp enough, purchase new ones. It is very frustrating to have your cord folding on you. If you have scissors already that you feel confident in, there is no need to purchase new ones.

While I did provide links to amazon to purchase the mirror, metal hoop, and scissors, these items can also be found at Hobby Lobby or other craft stores in town. I know it is sometimes hard to find these items on amazon that don't come in packs of 6 or more. Therefore, it may be in your best interest to purchase these in a store so you can buy them individually.

I would like to also encourage everyone to wear comfortable, supportive, closed-toe shoes. Depending on what works best for you, there is a good possibility you will be standing for majority of the class. We want to make sure to take care of our bodies while working! This includes a supportive base for our feet! I have also dropped scissors plenty of times that have gotten too close to be sticking into my foot.
