Supplies are available at Michaels, Hobby Lobby, Menningers (located in downtown Colorado Springs off of S Tejon St between E Las Animas St and E Fountain Blvd) and, Amazon, etc. Please bring an old apron and/or a large towel (please bring at least one) and clothes you don't mind getting dirty.

All of the tools that are listed are not necessary with exception to the standard 8 piece set. Purchase or bring the tools that are required for your projects. If you wish to make jars, calipers are required. If you wish to learn faceting, a cheese slicer is required, preferably one that has the limiter for cutting consistency as listed below.

Basic Safety and Guidelines:

Please cut nails as short as possible before class begins (this means VERY short) and hair past the shoulder must be tied up to prevent possible injury while operating the pottery wheel.
